



## University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio Integrates Invisalign® Into Dental School Curriculum

"Integrating the Invisalign system into our curriculum benefits the students by providing them with a therapeutic mechanism which can selectively be used in the treatment of orthodontic problems."

The Dental School at UTHSCSA, which celebrates its 35th anniversary this year, is committed to the enhancement of oral health through education, research, and patient care, and offers a curriculum that is based on contemporary and relevant technology, science and practice. Each year, approximately 90 students are admitted to the program.
